Church. Later a ward was organized with Porter as Bishop (Hendricks was Pres. of the Stake), David Jensen as first Councilor, etc. About 1900 he was made the first Sunday School Superintendent, and acted in this position for a number of years. He was appointed an alternate High-Councilman in the Oneida Stake.

At the age of 74 years he left this life to go to a greater field of labor, on January [9], 1909. 7 8
